DOES YOUR CHILD HAVE FOOD ALLERGIES?

We are currently inviting **children between 8-12 years old with food allergies and their caregivers** to participate in a project to **learn more about living safely with food allergies.**

We are studying how technology, specifically a computer program or “App,” named Food Allergy Adventure can be useful in educating children and their families about their food allergies.

- Taking part in this study involves a research assistant coming to the family’s home for two visits, plus an additional brief office visit with an allergist at Hasbro Children’s Hospital
- Children will use the App at home as much as they want to for 2 weeks between visits
- During the study, families will be asked to complete surveys and brief interviews about food allergies and their use of the App
- Families will be compensated for their time
