

















RSV, the Flu and COVID-19

Symptom Comparison

Symptoms	RSV	Flu	COVID-19
 Cause	Respiratory Syncytial Virus	Influenza Virus	SARS-COV-2
 Symptom Onset	Gradual	Sudden	Gradual
 Symptom Duration	7-14 Days	7-14 Days	7-25 Days
 Fever	Sometimes	Common	Common
 Cough	Common	Common	Common
 Runny or Stuffy Nose	Common	Sometimes	Common
 Sore Throat	Rare	Sometimes	Common
 Wheezing	Rare+	No***	No
 Rapid Breathing	Rare	No**	Rare
 Shortness of Breath/Difficulty Breathing	Rare+	No***	Common
 Sneezing	Sometimes	No	Rare
 Fatigue	Sometimes	Common	Common
 Muscle and Body Aches	Rare	Common	Common
 Loss of Taste and/or Smell	Rare	Rare	Common
 Diarrhea and Vomiting	Rare	Sometimes*	Sometimes
 Headache	Sometimes	Common	Common

*Diarrhea from flu is more common in children
**Shortness of breath from RSV is more common in infants and young children
***Allergies, colds and flu can trigger asthma which can lead to shortness of breath, chest tightness/pain and rapid breathing
+More common in infants and older adults

NOTE: If you have allergic asthma, it is possible to have symptoms of both asthma and allergies at the same time.
